



What we've heard

Summary of feedback received from our Public Consultation 16th – 31st July

Over 300 people attended our public exhibition weekend and our online exhibition received 1000 visits during the consultation period. More than 250 people completed our survey.

Feedback told us that there was support for...

- + Moulsecoomb Place and Gardens to be opened up to the public.
- + A cafe/restaurant - priced to serve the local community and students.
- + Public Events in buildings and gardens - community events, parties, weddings etc.
- + Work & training opportunities for local people.
- + More trees planted, easy access pathways & places to sit and enjoy the gardens.
- + Community space and services on site – with lots of ideas from the public on what would benefit the community.

You said: we listened...

- + Concerns for Moulsecoomb Social Club.

The Social Club will be retained on site. We are working closely with the Club to improve and enhance its facilities and broaden its membership.

- + Concerns around the height and mass of the student accommodation.

In response to your feedback, we have reduced the height of a number of the blocks and introduced architectural modeling to preserve important views.

- + Will an increase of student numbers in Moulsecoomb impact housing in the local area?

More student housing means more homes available for families and working people.

- + Concerns around the restoration of the Manor House and Tithe Barn.

The Listed Buildings will be preserved, restored and opened up as a public asset.

- + Lack of integration between the student community and local people.

We are intending to foster positive links between students and those who live locally. Public realm improvements, dedicated community facilities and the restoration of the Listed Buildings and gardens will provide a place for all to enjoy.
